MYTH

There is the modern myth that facts alone can inspire behaviour change and action for nature and people. But no one's ever been swayed by a pie chart. As humans, we're wired for narrative and captivating visuals. Our ancestors came together around crackling fires - not around powerpoint presentations. It was the stories that brought them together, not statistics. In stories we find meaning, connection, and ultimately, change. Data informs, imagery captivates, but stories transform.

GAP

In the English-speaking world, and even more so globally, there's an important story we're failing to tell. It's the story of how clean water bodies and water and sanitation services are fundamental to our well-being and the sustainable development agenda. We need to tell the water story with words and images that connect with people and highlight its interlinkages to climate justice, biodiversity loss, and planetary boundaries.

SOLUTION

Imagine a world where water connects, not just as a resource, but as a shared narrative. Onewater helps build this world by telling the stories that often get lost in the scroll. We break down complex issues, visualize data and invite communities to share their own water stories, amplifying them beyond text, borders and languages. Onewater's work rekindles our shared connection to water and positions it at the heart of decision-making and public discourse.

We invite you to support our annual photo story contest, which we've convened for the last three years in partnership with UNESCO's World Water Assessment Programme. This is not just a contest; it's a global platform for visual storytelling that aligns with the themes of the annual UN World Water Development Report. It's an opportunity to showcase powerful stories that can reshape public discourse on water-related issues.

GAIN VISIBILITY

Gain recognition at prestigious locations, including UN/UNESCO headquarters or public museums, and associate your brand with critical water-related causes and solutions. Your logo will be prominently displayed in all contest materials, and your contribution will be emphasized across our social media channels and partner networks. This connects you with a creative community dedicated to water issues and environmental advocacy. Any exhibitions with photos from the contest, like the "Walk of Water" in New York, will also prominently feature your organization's name and logo. Selected speaking opportunities may also be offered.

Receive access to a big archive of professional-grade photographs. The 2023 contest attracted over **700 photographers**, dozens of them Sony or World Press Photo award winners, who submitted a total of ~**7500 pictures** from around the world. All submissions include mandatory Creative Commons licenses that allow Onewater and its contest partners to make use of the images. Utilize these photographs in annual reports, newsletters, or on social media to illustrate your organization's environmental engagement. Enhance and support your CSR goals with authentic imagery for campaigns, presentations, and educational materials.

ACCESS NETWORKS

Connect with the best photographers and content-creators in your field and in your region and forge partnerships with international organizations to support water sustainability projects worldwide. This expands the impact of all partners' contributions beyond local or national boundaries.

Leveraging these stories will connect your brand to the broader environmental conversation through the art of visual storytelling. 


THE 2024/2025 ONEWATER PHOTOSTORY CONTEST

- document the impact of climate change and glacial retreat on nature and people from source-to-sea.

- explore how new, metaphorical 'water towers' are emerging. This could include innovative water management solutions, alternative sources of freshwater, or even artistic contributions.


THE JOURNEY SO FAR || COME ALONG
